

## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT between

## STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL And

## FAYETTE COUNTY CAREER AND TECHNICAL INSTITUTE

JUNE 2023 - JUNE 2024

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and Fayette County Career and Technical Institute jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the graduates successfully completing the Agricultural Production Operations program. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill in a major within the Department of Animal Science. A candidate from Fayette County Career and Technical Institute who:

- 1. Receives a Pennsylvania high school diploma
- Follows the Agricultural Production Operations curriculum and achieves an 85 or higher average in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for an Animal Science major
- 3. Has a written recommendation from the Agricultural Production Operations instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill, Department of Animal Science within the School of Agriculture and Natural Resources:

- Guaranteed admission into either the Agricultural Science AAS, Animal Industry AAS, Animal Science BT or BS degrees, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and that there is availability within the program
- Will receive advanced standing credits for SUNY Cobleskill's course ANSC 101-Foundations of Animal Science (3 credits)
- Will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGBU 101 -Introduction to Agricultural Business (3 credits)
- 4. Will receive advanced standing credits for SUNY Cobleskill's course ANSC 140 Small Animal Management (3 credits), after the student passes the challenge exam given during the first week of classes at SUNY Cobleskill

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Agricultural Production Operations instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is June 1, 2023 and will be reviewed for renewal, one year after signing, by the participating parties.

Persons not meeting these criteria have the option of applying to SUNY Cobleskill under regular admission procedure.
